MEMBERSHIP VOTE FEBRUARY 27

Q. WHAT IS THE VOTE FOR?

A. It is a vote to affirm HDC's Administrative Board's recommendation that Todd Arnett becomes HDC's Senior Pastor, beginning March 31, 2022.

Q. WHO GETS TO VOTE?

A. All members of HDC are eligible to vote. HDC's Church Constitution outlines how to become a member. You are a member of HDC and thereby eligible to vote if you:

1. Have completed HDC's membership class process. The classes themselves have taken on a variety of formats over the years (e.g. Discovery 101, The Ozone, Membership Lifepath, Membership Class). Having completed only one of those courses is required to maintain your membership status.

AND

2. Have signed and submitted to HDC's Administrative Board a formal application for church membership, also known as HDC's Membership Agreement.

AND

3. Were officially notified that your application was approved by vote of the Administrative Board.

AND

4. Have remained active through your attendance, volunteering, and/or financial support during the past six months. Inactive members are not allowed to vote.

Q. ARE MEMBERS REQUIRED TO VOTE?

A. No. Members are welcome to vote but are not required to do so.

Q. DO I HAVE TO BE PHYSICALLY PRESENT AT THE MEETING TO VOTE?

A. Yes, HDC's Church Constitution says that a quorum "shall be the eligible voting members present." No proxy votes are allowed.

Q. IF I DON'T KNOW TODD ARNETT VERY WELL, HOW SHOULD I KNOW WHICH WAY TO VOTE?

A. Todd Arnett served at HDC as an Associate Pastor for fifteen years, so he is at least fairly well known to most of our membership. But, if you feel as if you would like to get to know him better, you can ask someone you trust who actually does know him well, attend the *Townhall Meeting on February 20 at 4:00, and/or listen to his teachings at HDC's and Trinity Church of Redlands' websites.
